Policy for Evaluating Full-time Non-tenure Track Faculty

Non-tenure track faculty in keeping with TAUP article 15, section A limits the appointment to persons who are not charged with the tripartite mission of teaching, research and service but who specialize in one of the three missions and whose assignment is predominately in one of the three missions. Non-tenure track faculty will meet with their department chair on an annual basis to discuss the faculty member's responsibilities and performance. The School of Environmental Design Tenure and Promotion Procedures and Guidelines evaluation criteria that are relevant to the faculty member's predominate mission will be used as the basis for assessing performance and eligibility for reappointment, promotion and merit pay.
